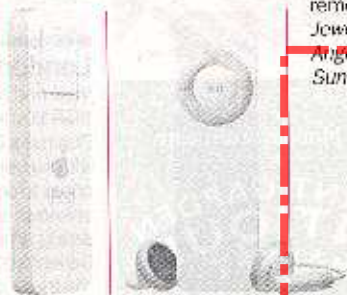
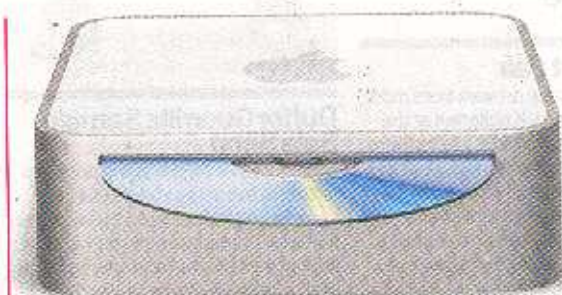

JUST OUT Mac mini + iPod shuffle

'If I had a nickel,' Steve Jobs sighed at last week's Macworld expo in San Francisco, 'for every time I've been asked why we don't make a stripped-down Mac that's more affordable...'

So he's gone and released one. If you've wanted to switch to the glorious and beautiful Mac operating system, expense may no longer be an excuse. From next Saturday, January 29, the Mac mini goes on sale worldwide for \$499 (£339 in the UK). It's adorably tiny, and although specs are basic (1.25GHz G4 processor, 256Mb RAM, 40Gb hard drive and so on) it should be powerful enough for many. Mind you, you need to supply a display, keyboard and mouse yourself, so it's best for people who have these from previous computers.

Meantime, those wanting an iPod will be pleased to see the arrival of the iPod shuffle at just £69 for 512Mb capacity, enough for 120 songs. Cute, of course, and tiny, though rechargeable battery life ain't great (12 hours). There's no display, so you choose either to play the playlist you've downloaded or shuffle to play the songs at random. Highly desirable. *David Pielton*
